- COUNCIL MEMBERS must register for the meeting in order to attend Council Meetings.
- ULI's policy for Members who are MARRIED OR PARTNERED is as follows: one full registration fee and one spouse registration fee will apply. Both will be considered full-meeting registrants. SPOUSE/PARTNER registration is required for attendance at all sessions.
- PUBLIC OFFICIAL/PUBLIC AGENCY MEMBERS are defined as elected or appointed full-time employees of a unit of local, state, or federal government or any agency thereof.
- ACADEMIC/NONPROFIT MEMBERS are defined as full-time, professional employees of colleges, universities, or nonprofit organizations.
- YOUNG LEADER MEMBERS are defined as current ULI Young Leader members who are under 35 years of age and pay Young Leader dues (\$250). Other ULI members who do not pay Young Leader dues are prohibited from registering in this category.
- STUDENTS are defined as those enrolled full time at accredited colleges and universities. Students must provide proof of full-time academic status or identification card with their membership form in order to receive the special registration fee.
