Pilot in 2019, Formal Program in 2020


- Operators Reapply Annually
- Scooters (2,000 permits)
 - 2022: Bird, Lime, Spin, Superpedestrian & Helbiz
 - 2021: Bird, Lime, Spin, Link, & Helbiz
 - Others previously: Razor, Bolt, Skip
- Ebikes (350 of 1,000 approved)
 - 2022: Lime & Bird
 - 2021: Lime

Complaints: Oct 2018 – June 2022




Arlington Reported Crashes: By Month


Crashes by Month



Arlington Reported Crashes: By Year




Corrals: Adding 100 in 2022




New in 2022: Equity Emphasis Area Deployments
