Background

- September 2014: TPB asked staff to develop a list of unfunded projects.
- October 2014: Citizens Advisory Committee passed resolution supporting the development of the list and calling for its use in regional planning and public involvement.
- February-May 2015: TPB staff solicited projects from members, which have been compiled and mapped.



Pulling Together the List

- More than 1,000 projects submitted
- Main project sources:
 - moveDC
 - Maryland county priority letters and other county projects
 - Maryland SHA Highway Needs Inventory
 - NVTA's TransAction 2040
 - WMATA's Momentum and Connect Greater Washington



Challenges

- Regional balance
- Cost estimates
- Pedestrian and bicycle projects

The list should not be viewed as a final product but as a resource for regional discussion and analysis.



Future Direction

Possible Uses:

- Use the list to define overall unfunded needs.
- Conduct regional analysis using the list.
- Identify subsets of highlighted projects.
- Promote project implementation.



Next Steps

Steering Committee recommendation:

- Establish a working group, chaired by a TPB member, to develop a scope and approach for future work.
- At the TPB meeting on June 17, TPB staff will seek Board concurrence to set up a working group.
