



The monthly APTA Transit Savings Report for March showed continued savings for public transit riders over driving a car. Riders of public transportation saved \$844 in March and \$10,120 annually. This includes the cost of commuting by public transportation compared to the cost of owning and driving a vehicle based on the March 26, 2012 average national gas price of \$3.90 per gallon-- as reported by AAA.
