RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECTION OF A PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT WITH THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE ON THE CYBERWATCH REGIONAL CENTER FOR CYBERSECURITY AND INFORMATION ASSURANCE

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) has a long history of advancing workforce development through partnerships with businesses, government agencies and institutes of higher education; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's Community College is the lead agency on the CyberWATCH project, funded by the National Science Foundation; and

WHEREAS, the CyberWATCH Regional Center -- representing a consortium of five community colleges, five universities, several high schools, government agencies and businesses -- is unique on the East Coast; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Center addresses challenges and concerns in education and the business community, specifically the shortage of security professionals; a perceived lack of business and team-work skills among information technology professionals and the lack of cybersecurity curriculum at many higher education institutions; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Center will prepare students to meet the specialized requirements of the security industry in the future job market.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to enter into a four-year partnership agreement with Prince George's Community College in which it will provide \$160,000 in funding support to COG (\$40,000 renewable annually), in return for which, COG will provide internship opportunities for students from the CyberWATCH communities and externships for the CyberWATCH consortium member community college faculty in the field of cybersecurity/information assurance and computer forensics.
