## **TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights**

The Technical Committee met on Friday, June 2 at COG. Four items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on June 21.

### • <u>TPB agenda Item 9</u>

Staff reviewed recent transit oriented development (TOD) activities, TOD institutional initiatives, and challenges in promoting TOD in the region. The Committee then discussed potential transportation incentive programs for achieving land use and transportation goals in the region.

#### • TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee was briefed on the regulatory requirement within SAFETEA-LU to prepare a conformity SIP update to address consultation and enforcement procedures, and provided a status report on the 8-hour ozone State Implementation Plan (SIP) work activities and schedule.

### • TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was updated on the draft Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan which was presented to the TPB at its May 17 meeting. The Committee recommended that the draft plan be released for public comment on June 15 and that the TPB adopt the plan at its July 19 meeting.

#### TPB agenda Item 13

Staff briefed the Committee on the status and schedule for completing the analysis of the financial plan for the 2006 CLRP. The Committee was also briefed on a draft report on the progress made since early 2004 in identifying resources to meet the region's currently unfunded transportation needs. As requested by the TPB, this report will inform the public and elected and appointed officials about the transportation funding accomplishments since 2004, highlight continuing funding challenges, and present potential long-term funding solutions.

Four items were presented for information and discussion:

- Staff updated the Committee on the status of the project submissions for the draft FY 2007- 2012 TIP.
- The Committee was briefed on details of a pilot project using volunteer drivers and GPS technology to record travel times and distances to enhance arterial highway congestion monitoring.
- The Committee was briefed on the results of applying the vehicle identification number (VIN) decoder to July 1, 2005 vehicle registration data.
- Staff briefed the Committee on the Fredericksburg Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (FAMPO) proposal to TPB for allocating and distributing annual FTA formula funds for the portion of the Washington urbanized area within Stafford County.
