## RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DEVELOPMENT AND ESTABLISHMENT OF A REGIONAL 2-1-1 SYSTEM FOR THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON REGION

**WHEREAS**, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) has a long history of supporting the development of region-wide resources and sound regional responses to such issues as emergency response and social services; and

**WHEREAS**, prior COG actions have included the creation of the Regional Emergency Coordination Plan (RECP<sup>SM</sup>) and the National Capitol Region Emergency Preparedness Council to strengthen the region's communication and coordination in the event of a regional incident or emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has designated "2-1-1" as the national abbreviated dialing code for free access to information on and referral to health and human services; and

**WHEREAS**, three 2-1-1 plans are currently in development - one each for the District of Columbia, the State of Maryland, and the Commonwealth of Virginia; and

**WHEREAS**, a multi-jurisdictional hotline for information and referrals to social services would connect are residents to existing services and strengthen the region's preparedness for an emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, a number of government officials and non-profit groups are working with planners from 2-1-1 initiatives in the District of Columbia, Maryland, and Virginia to develop a seamless, comprehensive 2-1-1 system for the region that will match the public with essential services; and

**WHEREAS**, legislation introduced in the United States Congress (The Calling for 2-1-1 Act of 2003) seeks to increase access to 2-1-1 telephone services by authorizing a dedicated federal funding source to support 2-1-1 development nationwide; and

WHEREAS, Human Services Policy Committee endorsed the following action.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

- 1. The COG jurisdictions are urged to support a regional 2-1-1 system that will provide area citizens with a broad range of referral services. Substance abuse and mental health services should be a critical component of this comprehensive referral system
- 2. The United States Congress is urged to pass H.R. 3111 and S. 1630, bills to facilitate the availability of 2-1-1 telephone service for information and referral on human services and for other purposes
