TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights

The Technical Committee met on Friday, April 7 at COG. Five items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on April 19.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 9</u>

Staff briefed the Committee on the updated project submissions for the 2006 CLRP and FY 2007-2012 TIP. The Committee recommended that the Board approve the project submissions for inclusion in the conformity analysis for the 2006 CLRP and the FY 2007-2012 TIP at its April 19 meeting.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 10</u>

The Committee was briefed on revisions to the draft scope of work for the air quality conformity assessment of the 2006 CLRP and FY 2007-2012 TIP. The Committee recommended that the Board approve the revised conformity assessment scope of work at its April 19 meeting.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 11</u>

Staff briefed the Committee on the draft Commuter Connections Work Program (CCWP) for FY 2007 (July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007). The Committee recommended that the Board approve the FY 2007 CCWP at its April 19 meeting.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 13</u>

FHWA staff briefed the Committee on the summary certification report on the TPB transportation planning process.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 15</u>

Staff briefed the Committee on the status and schedule for completing the analysis of the financial plan for the 2006 CLRP. Staff also summarized three MPO programs presented at the March 15 TPB meeting that use transportation funding to support transit-oriented development (TOD) in activity centers. The Committee identified several examples of TOD projects in this region that could provide lessons on the value of such transportation funding. It also provided comments on the potential for such a program in this region.

Two items were presented for information and discussion:

- The Committee was briefed on a Draft Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan for the National Capital Region which has been developed by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Subcommittee.
- The Committee was briefed on three ongoing air quality planning activities: a program to use vehicle identification numbers (VIN) to develop age distribution inputs for the Mobile 6.2 emissions model; a comparison of monthly and seasonal methods to estimate mobile source emissions; and a status report on the 8-hour ozone State Implementation Plan (SIP) work activities and schedule.
