The Transportation Alternatives Program is a new federal program under MAP-21 that combines three former federal programs: Transportation Enhancements (TE), Safe Routes to Schools (SRTS), and Recreational Trails (RTP).

Under the TA Program large MPOs, including the Transportation Planning Board, will play a new role in project selection for a portion of program funds. In the National Capital Region the TA Program will be framed as a complementary component of the TPB's Transportation/Land-Use Connections (TLC) Program, which provides technical assistance for small planning studies to TPB member jurisdictions. The Subcommittee will be briefed on the regional funding application process.
