1,500 officials and experts come to COG each month to make connections, share information, and develop solutions to the region's major challenges

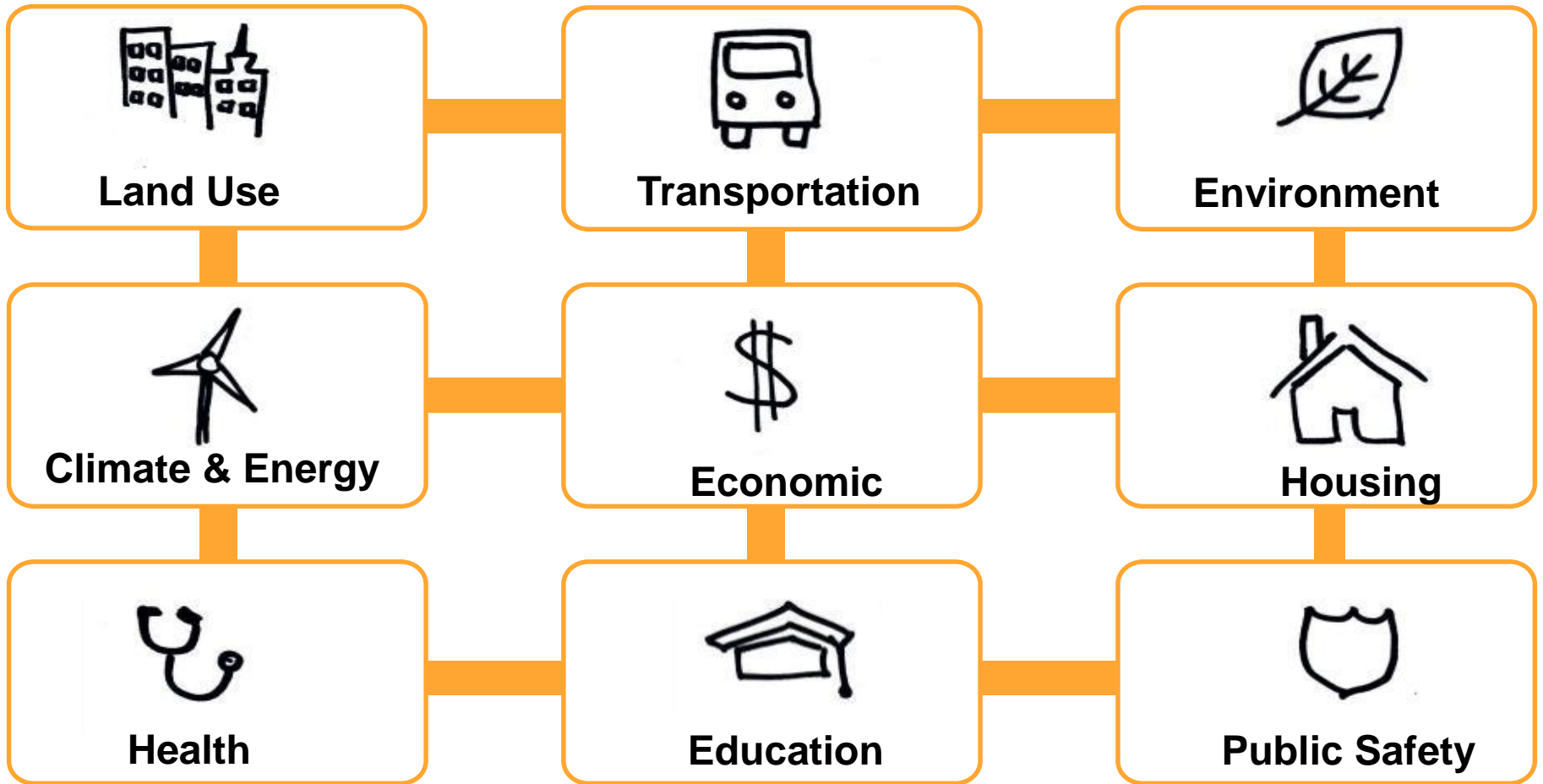


Staff and Work Program
