11:25 A.M. 3. HEALTHY MEALS, HEALTHY KIDS ACT AND CHILDHOOD NUTRITION

Crystal FitzSimons, Director of School and Out-of-School Time Programs, Food Research and Action Center (FRAC's)

Virginia Representative Bobby Scott recently introduced H.R. 8450, the <u>Healthy Meals</u>, <u>Healthy Kids Act</u>. The bill was passed out of committee before Congress's August recess.

FRAC's Crystal FitzSimons will provide an overview of the bill's key provisions, including major proposed improvements since Childhood Nutrition Reauthorization was last approved in 2010. She may also provide other federal updates on changes to key childhood nutrition programs as the beginning of the new school year approaches.
