

MEETING NOTES CAR FREE DAY 2017 July 12, 2017

1. Introductions

Committee members, guests and other attendees introduced themselves by name and affiliation.

2. Approval of the Meeting Minutes

The minutes from the May 10, 2017 meeting were approved as written.

3. Poster Concepts

The Committee was presented with seven poster concepts for consideration. The poster selected by a majority vote was 'Drop it For a Day', containing a visual of a hand dropping a car key. Final changes will be made based on Committee feedback, and the poster will be distributed at least one month prior to Car Free Day. A pdf of the final poster will be available on the web site for download, and the eps version will be provided by request. The web site header and social media sites will be populated with the 2017 poster graphics.

4. Radio Scripts

The 30 second companion radio script 'Drop it For a Day' was reviewed by the Committee and feedback was given to make modifications. It begins, 'Tired of sitting in traffic? Try something new and drop your keys for a day.' The radio spot will be produced in mid-August, and air during the first three weeks of September.

5. Proclamation

The Car Free Day proclamation will take place at the July 19th Transportation Planning Board (TPB) meeting. The enlarged proclamation will be ceremonially signed by TPB Chair and City of Rockville Mayor, Bridget Newton. The signing will be streamed live on Facebook, and a photo will be posted to the Car Free Day web site and Twitter account. Board members will be asked to adopt similar proclamations within their jurisdictions.
