- 2011: Ad-hoc committee formed to implement strategies of the *Urban Heat Island Mitigation/Tree Planting/Canopy Conservation and Management* measure included in 2007 8-Hour Ozone SIP
- 2013: The Regional Tree Canopy Workgroup presents an Workgroup recommendations to CEEPC and CBPC
 - Recommendation #1: Utilize the full potential of urban forests to mitigate climate change and to address regulatory concerns
- 2018: Tree Canopy Management Strategy released

- 2019: CEEPC forms Tree Canopy Management Subcommittee CBPC supports work for water quality
 - 2-year charter

Purpose


- Communicates goals and recommendations that local governments can use to conserve, manage and expand their tree canopy to help maximize the environmental health and quality of life

- Establish an on-going forest policy committee
- Align regional urban forestry initiatives and metrics with the Region Forward Vision




COG Member Policy/Programs, 2018
