1. CALL TO ORDER, INTRODUCTIONS

2. MWAQC LETTER TO TPB ON TRANSPORTATION CONFORMITY

Jane Posey, COG Department of Transportation Planning Steve Walz, COG Director of Environmental Programs

Ms. Posey and Mr. Walz briefed MWAQC members on the air quality conformity analysis of the Visualize 2045 Long Range Plan and FY2019-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (see slides posted on the MWAQC meeting site link below).

Members reviewed the comment letter and discussed changes to the following sections:

- Adding a phrase in the second paragraph indicating that the goal of keeping emissions within the Tier 1 levels. Some transportation agencies objected to statements suggesting restrictions on the use of the Tier 2 budgets, since they provide the flexibility needed to allow for changes in planning assumptions that are largely out of the region's control.
- Removing the clause beginning with "in particular..." at the end of the sixth paragraph so as not to appear overly critical of the transportation planning process.
- Adding a phrase that articulates that the region will face more difficult efforts to reduce emissions if federal standards are rolled back.
- Several minor edits were included, including removing the words "in-depth" from the seventh paragraph.

Following discussion, the letter was approved. The voting total on the letter as amended was 6 ayes, 4 nays, 2 abstentions.

The comment letter will be submitted to the Transportation Planning Board.
