



#### **SIP** Measures

- Regular Measures = Regulatory
- Innovative Measures = Non-regulatory
  - Non-regulatory "voluntary" measures are bundled.
  - States must true-up and backfill shortfalls.




#### Voluntary Bundle

#### **Reductions Credited**

- Low-VOC Consumer Products
- •Wind Power Purchase
- •Gas Can Replacement
- Use of Low-VOC Paint
- Reduce Locomotive Idling

Included, But No Credit Taken

- Alternative Fueled Vehicle Purchase
- Remote Sensing Device
- Diesel Retrofits (School and Transit Buses)




#### Voluntary Bundle in 1-hour Ozone SIP

- EPA SIP Approval on May 12, 2005.
- Programs:
  - Gasoline Container Replacements
  - Low-VOC Paint
  - Wind Power Purchases
  - Alternative Fueled Vehicle Purchases
  - Diesel Retrofits
  - Remote Sensing Devices
  - Sale of Reformulated Consumer Products
- 2005 Credits: 0.2 tpd (NOx) and 3.2 tpd (VOC)





# Emission Reductions in 1-Hr SIP by Source Category



## Maximum Voluntary SIP Credit

- Total SIP credit potential is 9%
  - Stationary Sources (3%)
  - Mobile Sources (3%)
  - Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy Measures (3%)
