Under the federal Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TA Set Aside) Program, the TPB is
responsible for selecting projects using sub-allocated funding for Suburban Maryland, Northern
Virginia, and the District of Columbia. For FY 2020, the solicitation period for applications for the
District of Columbia is March 26 - May 17. The solicitation for Maryland will be April 15 - May 15.
Pre-applications for Virginia are due on July 1.
