RESOLUTION ENDORSING WILDIFE-VEHICLE COLLISION AVOIDANCE POLICY STATEMENT AND WILDLIFE-VEHICLE COLLISION REDUCTION WORKING GROUP REPORT

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) has sought methods to protect the public health and safety of the citizens of the Washington metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, COG has worked to address the problems of animal protection throughout the Washington metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, the COG Animal Services Committee, identified wildlife-vehicle collisions as an immediate and continuing public safety issue impacting the Washington metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, the COG Animal Services Committee, the Wildlife-Vehicle Collision Reduction Working Group, and the COG Public Safety Policy Committee have developed and reviewed a *Wildlife-Vehicle Collision Avoidance Policy Statement* and *Deer Vehicle Collision Report* which supports recognition of wildlife-vehicle collisions as a public safety issue that impacts people, animals and property; and

WHEREAS, the COG Public Safety Policy Committee issued an endorsement of the *Wildlife-Vehicle Collision Avoidance Policy Statement* and *Deer Vehicle Collision Report* on September 15, 2006.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

- 1. The *Wildlife-Vehicle Collision Avoidance Policy Statement* and *Report* is endorsed by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments Board of Directors.
