RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE FANNIE MAE FOUNDATION

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) has established several publicprivate partnerships to further its mission and work program; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Area Housing Partnership (WAHP) was established in 1991 and seeks to preserve and expand the supply of affordable housing in the Washington metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, the Potomac Regional Education Partnership (PREP) was established in 1998 and became part of COG in November 2001 and seeks to promote regional workforce and education policies and programs; and

WHEREAS, the Fannie Mae Foundation currently provides grant funding support to the WAHP and PREP and requested that the COG submit a consolidated funding application on behalf of all three projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to submit a consolidated funding a pplication to the Fannie Mae Foundation on behalf of the Council of Governments' WAHP and PREP programs. Funding not to exceed \$250,000 is requested (WAHP - \$125,000 and PREP - \$125,000). No COG matching funds are required.
