Final Project: mini-Technical Assistance Panels (mTAPs)


- Based on ULI Washington's TAP program
- Teams of 5 work over 2 month period on targeted local land use issue
- Sites:
 - Reuse of the 11th Street Recreational Bridge, Washington DC
 - Affordable Housing on Columbia Pike, Arlington
 - TOD at Landover Metro Station, Prince Georges County
 - Attracting Investment to Woodlawn CBC, Fairfax
 - Placemaking at Seven Corners, Fairfax



Examples of recommendations: Seven Corners

Create a "Main Boulevard" via an elevated park that overcomes transportation and topographical barriers

- Aggressively pursue fund raising & grants
- Public art
- Coordinate with other new development
- Improve & expand existing pedestrian bridge






Examples of recommendations: Columbia Pike
