**WHEREAS**, COG plays an important role in assisting member jurisdictions coordinate activities and promote best practices; and

**WHEREAS**, the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Committee, the Health Officials Committee, and the Corrections Chiefs Committee have together identified a need for coordinated regional planning to improve access to care for individuals with mental health and/or substance abuse disorders; and

**WHEREAS**, the Quality Health Foundation seeks grant applications from non-profit organizations to improve the health status of individuals and communities.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:**

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to submit a grant proposal to the Quality Health foundation for the support of an *Improving Healthcare of Individuals with Mental Health and Substance Abuse Disorders Using Regional Learning Collaboratives* program. Funding in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 is requested for a period of one year. No COG matching funds will be required.
