RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT TO PROVIDE ANACOSTIA RIVER WATERSHED PARTNERSHIP-RELATED SUPPORT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) is a nationally recognized watershed restoration expert and has provided coordination, management, and technical support for the Anacostia restoration effort since 1987; and

WHEREAS, COG has a continuing interest in the restoration, management and protection of the Anacostia River and its tributaries; and

WHERAS, at its June 14, 2006 meeting the COG Board adopted Resolution R28-06 establishing the Anacostia Restoration Partnership (Partnership), including the formation of a new Anacostia Watershed Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the state of Maryland has a vested interest in the restoration of the Anacostia River and its tributaries, and is an active voting and dues-paying member of the Anacostia Watershed Steering Committee (AWSC) and Anacostia Watershed Management Committee (AWMC); and

WHEREAS, implementation of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Anacostia Watershed Restoration Plan is a high priority for both the AWSC and AWMC, and COG's assistance in providing technical assistance is critical: and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on June 24, 2010, the Steering Committee adopted the annual Work Program and Budget for FY 2011; and

WHEREAS, Maryland, as a dues-paying member of the Partnership, helps to underwrite the annual work program and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a memorandum of understanding to provide Anacostia governance-related services, consistent with the annual WP&B, to the Maryland Department of the Environment and support for implementation of the Anacostia Watershed Restoration Plan. The contractual services identified in the MOU will not exceed \$41,500, with funding provided by MDE. No COG matching funds are required. The period of performance is one year.
