9:50 A.M. 6. VISUALIZE 2050: BRIEFING ON PROJECT INPUTS AND DRAFT SCOPE OF WORK FOR THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY ANALYSIS FOR THE VISUALIZE 2050 NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND THE FY2026-2029 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

The committee will receive a briefing summarizing the project inputs submitted by December 29, 2023 for inclusion in the Visualize 2050 Air Quality Conformity (AQC) process. Given the federal status of the TPB's planning area (designated as "non-attainment" of the federal 2015 Ozone Standard), the projects proposed to be included in the Visualize 2050 financial plan and TIP must undergo a regional air quality conformity determination analysis. The TPB's National Capital Region Transportation Plan and FY 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program must be updated, reviewed, and approved by federal agencies upon TPB approval scheduled for June 2025. The committee will be briefed on the projects submitted for the update and the draft scope of work for the air quality conformity analysis. The 30-day public comment on the inputs and scope is scheduled from March 1 to March 30, 2024. In addition, a work session will be held immediately prior to the March 21 TPB meeting.

10:35 A.M. 7. MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (MDOT) UPDATE ON CARBON REDUCTION PROGRAM

The committee will be briefed on a study of implementation considerations for onroad GHG reduction strategies and asked to provide feedback. On June 15, 2022, the TPB adopted on-road transportation sector GHG reduction goals of 50 percent below 2005 levels by 2030 and 80 percent below 2005 levels by 2050. Part of the approval was adoption of seven GHG reduction strategies as priorities and identification of seven additional greenhouse gas reduction strategies that merit further discussion, which are the subject of this study.
