Highway Conditions - Asset Management Plan Rule

NPRM published February 20:

- Contents and development process for asset management plan.
- Minimum standards for pavement and bridge management systems.
- The plan is focused on requirements for State DOTs to manage the condition of the National Highway System through an asset management plan.
 - For MPOs there is only a paragraph (p. 9241) stating that MPOs would be required to include in the metropolitan planning process the developed asset management plan.

Asset Management Plan Rule

- Under the rule, State DOTs would have five requirements for NHS asset management:
 - 1. Conduct a performance gap analysis and identify strategies to close gaps
 - 2. Conduct life-cycle cost analysis
 - 3. Undertake risk management analysis
 - 4. Develop a financial plan for 10 years
 - 5. Develop investment strategies to improve or preserve asset condition and NHS performance.

MAP-21 - Next Steps in Regional Coordination

- Coordination discussions with State DOTs and Public Transportation Providers:
 - Each agency to identify representatives for each category/measure.
 - Share information on known and proposed performance provisions and regulatory requirements for each category/measure.
 - Initial discussion on basis for further coordination.
- Subsequent combined workshop to discuss MAP-21 performance provisions, with FHWA/FTA and consultants.
