- More private office than downtown Denver, Dallas, LA























# Worksite Impact: With TDM at Worksites Transit use is doubled, SOV 20% lower

Offered – 2013 COG State of Commute






## Jurisdiction Level Impact: Arlington

- 41,000 SOV trips shifted off the roads to other modes each workday (1 freeway lane = 4,000 6,000 vehicles in peak period) 2014 estimate Arlington and region
- 718,000 miles of travel reduced daily
- 31,000 gallons of fuel saved/day, 8.1 million/yr.
- 350 tons of emissions reduced/day



#### **Pedestrian Crosswalk Safety Operation** Set-Up Diagram for Posted Speed Limit of 25 mph











## Focus: Employer Services





- A major service provider to Arlington's business community
- 785 employer clients, 146,000 employees 66% of workforce
- 69% provide transit benefit \$18M/year in private incentives
- 316 residential clients, 68,000 units 85% penetration

- Site Plan developer clients assist compliance

### Focus: TDM for Site Plan Development

Goal: offer more and better choices at the building level.

- Incorporate important physical infrastructural features (bike parking standards, van-accessible garages), into new or renovated development at the time of construction.
- Actively monitor more than 100 (and counting) site plans to ensure they meet ongoing transportation management program responsibilities:
  - Promoting participation in carpool and vanpool programs
  - Offer transit subsidies to employees
  - Offer showers and lockers for bike commuters
  - Distribute brochures about the bikeway system, bus routes and schedules, and other local transportation options.
