## FY 2009 Project Solicitation

### October 15, 2008 – December 19, 2008

- Increase TPB funding to \$180,000, plus \$80,000 commitment from MDOT Technical Assistance funds
- Provide for a range of technical assistance between \$10,000 and \$60,000

- Manassas Park, Marketing the Redevelopment Potential of TOD \$20,000
- Prince William County, Mixed-Use Development at Commuter Rail Stations -\$30,000 \*



## FY 2009 Project Completion Schedule

## Selection/Approval Process: January – February 2009

 Convened the Selection Panel on January 27 to select projects to recommend to the TPB for approval at the February 18 TPB Meeting.

## Delivery of Technical Assistance: March – June 2009, Carryover to FY 2010

 Given the diverse scale of the projects, several projects may require carryover into FY 2010, though some may be complete by June 30, 2009.

## Schedule for FY 2010 TLC Program

#### Program Structure and Criteria the same as for FY 2009

#### **Project Solicitation: March - May 2009**

 Issue a call for projects for the FY 2010 technical assistance program on March 16, 2009, with a May 18, 2009, due date.

#### **Convene Selection Panel: June 2009**

 Appoint a selection panel to recommend projects for funding for the FY 2010 technical assistance program.

#### **Delivery of Technical Assistance: Begin July 2009**

 Tentatively schedule TPB approval of FY 2010 technical assistance projects for the July 15 TPB meeting.

## Approval of Schedule for the FY 2010 TLC Program

- March 16, 2009: Release call for projects for FY 2010 technical assistance (pre-application conference will be held within two weeks).
- May 18, 2009: Applications are due by 4:00 p.m.
- June 2009: Convene selection panel to review and recommend slate of projects for FY 2010.
- July 15, 2009: Request TPB approval of FY 2010 TLC Technical Assistance projects. 7
