Background

Car Free Day is an internationally recognized event which started in Europe in 2000 as a day for residents to leave their cars at home, and instead get around by cleaner and more sustainable methods of travel for both commute and non-commute purposes. Travel modes include public transportation, bicycling, walking, and scootering. In the Washington, DC region Car Free Day began in 2008 and is coordinated by Commuter Connections and its network partners. Car Free Day in the National Capital region also includes the option to participate by traveling "car lite" (carpool or vanpool) and also teleworking.

A regional marketing campaign promoted the Car Free Day event held on September 22, 2022, which helped to yield 4,054 pledges, a 35 percent increase over the previous year.

Three main objectives of the Car Free Day marketing campaign were to:

- 1. Use the event as an opportunity to promote alternative modes of transportation for both commute and non-commute trips.
- 2. Encourage commuters and the general public to take the online pledge to use car free or car-lite travel methods on Car Free Day.
- 3. Measure and report impacts, as part of the Commuter Connections Regional TDM Mass Marketing program.



Proclamation

The Car Free Day 2022 Proclamation signing took place at the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) meeting on July 20, 2022. Pamela Sebesky, City of Manassas Vice Mayor and TPB Chair, signed the enlarged proclamation and officially decreed September 22, 2022 as Car Free Day in the Washington, DC region.

WHEREAS, Car Free Day benefits the National Capital Region through improved air quality, mobility, energy conservation, and reduced parking demands; and

WHEREAS, Car Free Day corresponds with the culmination of European Mobility Week's celebration of sustainable mobility from September 16-22, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board:

- 1. Proclaims Car Free Day throughout the Washington Metropolitan region to be observed on Thursday, September 22, 2022; and
- 2. Encourages those who live and work in the region to take the pledge to be Car Free or Car-lite at www.CarFreeMetroDC.org; and
- 3. Acknowledges TPB member jurisdictions who have adopted similar proclamations in support of Car Free Day 2022.

Poster

Images for Car Free Day 2022 were updated from the previous year to reflect a post-COVID environment and movement back to the physical workplace. Specifically, health/safety language and images with travelers wearing face coverings were removed. A mailing was sent to employers with a cover letter and flyer. The poster was also made available in PDF format at www.carfreemetrodc.org.



Media

Car Free Day challenged drivers to leave their cars home for the day and go car free or car-lite. The campaign promoted the use of alternative modes of transportation such as taking transit, carpooling, vanpooling, bicycling, scootering and walking. Participating by teleworking was also included. The event encouraged workers, residents, and students to take the Car Free Day pledge to improve mobility and air quality. The campaign also engaged employers, area universities, and the general public.

The Car Free Day media buy consisted of radio spots, text messages, , a YouTube video, sponsored article, social media influence, and digital banner ads. Other efforts to promote Car Free Day included posters, social media and earned media.


YouTube Video

A paid sponsored article on PoPville, a popular local blog chronicling D.C. area neighborhood happenings, was utilized to help reach local audiences.









2022 Pledge Summary

By Jurisdiction

All COG jurisdictions participated in support of Car Free Day 2022 and generated pledges. The District of Columbia was the number one jurisdiction, with 1,199 (30%) of the total pledges, followed by Montgomery County 809 (20.0%), and Arlington County 657 (16%). Triple digit pledges were also generated by other jurisdictions in the following order: Fairfax County, Prince George's County, City of Alexandria, Loudoun County, and Prince William County.

By Travel Mode

Participants were asked to select the mode(s) they would use on Car Free Day 2022. Participants could select more than one travel mode, and the average number of travel modes per person was 2.2. The breakdown was as follows: Telework 1,855 (46%), Walk/Run 2,515 (62%), Bicycle/Scooter 1,866 (46%), Train 1,255 (31%), Bus 982 (24%), and Carpool/Vanpool 363 (9%).

By Alt Mode/SOV

Participants who self-identified as typical drive alone travelers made up 969 (24%) of the pledges, and those normally car-free accounted for 3,085 (76%) pledges.

By State

With 1,580 (39%), Virginia had the greatest number of pledges in 2022, followed by Maryland at 1,230 (30%), and the District of Columbia at 1,199 (30%). Other states received 45 pledges (1%).


By Activity


Those who took the pledge in 2022 were engaged in the following activities on Car Free Day: Working 3,574 (82%), Recreation/Exercise 1,936 (48.0%), Shopping/Errands 1,168 (29%), Dining Out/Entertainment 715 (18%), Taking Classes 300 (7%), and Other 464 (10%).

By Work Location

On Car Free Day 2022, 1,939 (48%) Commuted to their Standard Workplace Location, 1,757 (43%) Worked From Home, 413 (10%) were Not Working/Other, and 98 (2%) commuted to a Co-working/Shared Workspace/Telework Center.

Emissions Impacts

COG/TBP staff prepared a Car Free Day emissions impacts analysis which documents the method used to estimate mobile/on-road emissions (in tons) saved on Car Free Day 2022. The emissions



savings were based on pledged vehicle miles traveled

(VMT) savings as stated by participants using non-single occupant vehicle modes of travel on September 22, 2022. Emissions rates developed by EPA's MOVES model were used.

Nitrogen oxides (NOx) are the chemical in automotive exhaust; volatile organic compounds (VOC) are ground-water contaminants; greenhouse gases (GHG) are released into the atmosphere which absorb and emit radiation; and particulate matter (PM) are microscopic matter suspended in the earth's atmosphere.
