1. APPROVAL OF REGIONAL BIKE TO WORK DAY 2021 PROCLAMATION Nicholas Ramfos, Transportation Operations Programs Director

In an effort to increase public awareness of the viability of bicycle commuting in the Washington region, regional Bike to Work Day events are being organized at over 90 locations in the region for Friday, May 21. These events will encourage the business community and other regional decision-makers to support increased bicycle commuting through bicycle-friendly policies and initiatives.

2. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF TWO RESOLUTIONS TO AMEND THE FY 2021-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

TPB SR14-2021: an amendment to include funding for the I-95 Spot Improvements at Opitz Boulevard and Van Buren Road Extension projects in Prince William County, as requested by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT). Both projects are included in the Air Quality Conformity Analysis of the 2020 Amendment to Visualize 2405 and the FY 2021-2024 TIP. The amendment for the Van Buren Road Extension is limited to a study only thus exempting this portion of the project from the air quality conformity requirement. This amendment is in the Project InfoTrak database as TIP Action 21-22.

TPB SR15-2021: an amendment to include funding for the Southbound Kenilworth Ave NE Reconstruction project and three project groupings related to streetlights throughout the District of Columbia: Streetlight Asset Management, Streetlight Construction, and Citywide Streetlight P3, as requested by the District Department of Transportation (DDOT). These projects are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement of the TIP. This amendment is saved in the Project InfoTrak database as TIP Action 21-23.
