1. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE CRITICAL URBAN FREIGHT CORRIDOR DESIGNATION UPDATES FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA Andrew Meese, TPB Transportation Planner

In accordance with federal transportation law, the TPB designated the region's Critical Urban Freight Corridors (CUFCs) in 2017 (Resolution R6-2018), with amendments approved by the TPB Steering Committee in 2021 (Resolution SR4-2022). With changes enacted in the recent Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) plus an upcoming update to the District of Columbia's official state freight plan, TPB has an opportunity to update and expand CUFC designations within the District. The committee will be asked to approve SR6-2024 to authorize these CUFC updates.

Action: Adopt resolution SR6-2024 to authorize designation updates for Critical Urban Freight Corridors within the District of Columbia.

Action: Adopt TPB Resolution SR7-2024 to amend the TIP to include TIP Action 23-25.2 which adds funding for the MD 4 at Suitland Parkway Interchange Construction project, as requested by MDOT.
