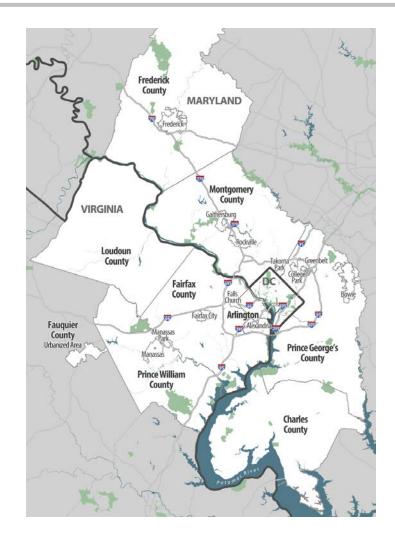

MPO Responsibilities

- National Capital Region
 Transportation Planning Board
 (TPB) is the federally designated
 Metropolitan Planning
 Organization (MPO) for the region
- Plays an important role as the regional forum for transportation planning
- Prepares plans and programs that the federal government must approve in order for federal-aid transportation funds to flow to metropolitan Washington





MPO Revenue

- MPO is NOT a direct recipient of federal funding!
- As a subrecipient, we are subject to additional oversight from our direct recipients – the state DOTs
- Federal Funding 80%: FHWA PL and FTA Section 5303
- Local 10% (COG dues) and State 10% match (state DOT funding)
- The total for FY 2018 comes from 3 "buckets" of funding:
 - "New" Federal FY 2017 funding
 - "Old" funding from the FY 2016 UPWP that was not spent but is owed to us after the books were closed (called "unexpended")
 - "Current" FY 2017 UPWP funding that we anticipate not being able to spend by June 30, 3017

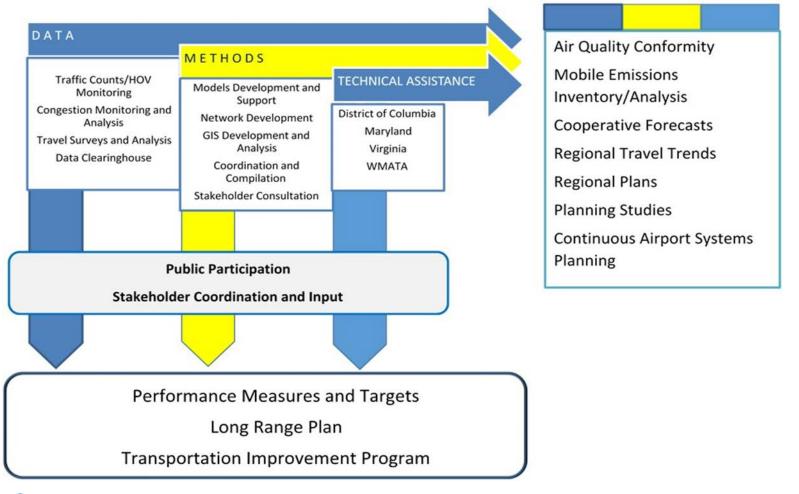
