- b) Nonroad & On-road model sources COG will develop using MOVES2014a.

<u>2025 & 2030</u>

- a) Point (EGU only) sources States will develop these.
- b) NEGU, Area and MAR sources COG will project emissions using growth factors developed from appropriate surrogates
 - i. Sources using Population, Employment, and Households as surrogates will be grown using COG Co-operative Round 9.0
 - ii. Sources using VMT as surrogates will be grown using TPB VMT projections
- c) Nonroad & On-road model sources COG will develop using MOVES2014a.
