

System Benefit Charge

- Charged per unit
- Based on classification of property

Ex: Small business


Ex: Small Multi-family



Developing the Opt-In Program

2013: Survey

Late 2017: Request for Information/Proposal



Recommended property criteria

Small multi-family properties

<10 units

Small businesses

Not served by another entity

Certain BPRUC

5,000 sq ft

Within existing routes

Recommended Program Rules

SBC

- No Opting out
- Occupancy wouldn't determine the charge
- Rolling Opt-in after initial term

Program Specifics

- Rules for the program would be the same as residential
 - Carts
 - Penalty for "trashing" the stream

Developing the Opt-In Program

> Residential Curbside Recycling Opt-In Program Multi-Family Properties and Small Businesses

Dear Property Owner:

Owners of small multi-family properties and some small businesses have expressed to Frederick County Government an interest in receiving curbside recycling service. Until now, the Residential Curbside Recycling Program has been available only to single-family residences and townhomes. We are pleased to announce expanded availability of this service to multi-family properties with nine (9)

Implementing the Opt-In Program

- Preparations included:
 - Setting up the SOP
 - Training staff (within and between Divisions)
 - Alerting the contractor and training their staff
- 258 MF, 102 SB properties identified
- □ July 2018: Initial roll out to 13 properties
- Rolling Opt-in option




| Year | Total |
|------|-------------|
| 2018 | 13 |
| 2019 | 12 |
| 2020 | 5 |
| 2021 | 1 (so far!) |

□ 1st year: 50:50 split

Remaining years: 2:1, multi-family : business

- Ensuring residential material




Challenges of Multi-Family Recycling

Contamination!

- Transient populations
 - Different rules, languages, expectations
- Accessibility
 - Location relative to trash dumpsters
- Theft
 - Unknown users of the dumpsters
