At this town hall meeting, you can:

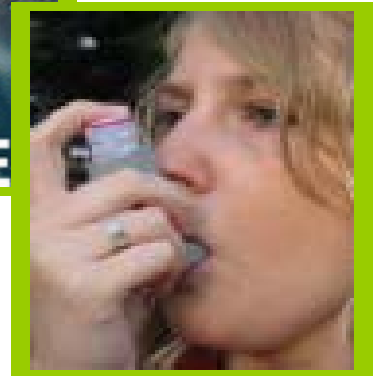
- Learn about health effects from particle pollution and climate change
