- Maryland's 2030 Greenhouse Gas Reduction Act (GGRA) Plan lays out the state's approach to Maryland's greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction goals. The plan calls for a goal of 50 percent reductions by 2030, as recommended by the Maryland Commission on Climate Change. With federal actions on climate

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change anticipated, Maryland expects to be able to achieve that goal. The state's 50 percent by 2030 goal aligns with the metropolitan Washington GHG reduction goal, as recommended by CEEPC.

**11:25 A.M. 5. TRANSPORTATION PLANNING BOARD (TPB) CLIMATE CHANGE MITIGATION STUDY OF 2021**

The goal of this study is to demonstrate potential pathways for the region to reduce on-road transportation sector GHG emissions to meet regional GHG reduction goals in 2030 and 2050. The study is divided into two phases: Phase 1, conducted by TPB staff, is a summary of major findings from past work done in this area by TPB and COG. Phase 2 is a technical analysis conducted by a consultant. At today's meeting, TPB staff will summarize the findings of the Phase 1 report that will be used as reference for Phase 2 of the study.
