
WASTE MANAGEMENT HIERARCHY

5 EASY STEPS TO REDUCE PLASTIC WASTE

Say no to plastic straws at restaurants



Bring a reusable bag whenever you shop



Pack your lunch in reusable containers





Use reusable water bottles instead of disposable bottled water

Reduce your impact this #PlasticFreeJuly by using a reusable tote bag instead of plastic bags at the store. If you drive, a good tip is to keep a stash of reusable tote bags in your trunk or put your shopping list in a bag so you're less likely to forget! Some stores will give you a discount for every reusable bag you bring and use.



Packing your lunch in a **reusable container** is a great way to reduce single use waste. It is never too late to join us this <u>#PlasticFreeJuly!</u> Meal prepping can often help save money too!









Reduce **Holiday Waste**



Purchase wrapping paper made with recycled materials that will also be recyclable and reuse tissue and wrapping paper. Remember, metallic/glitter wrapping paper are not recyclable



Keep Tanglers Out of the Bin

Please remember to keep items that tangle out of the recycling bin this holiday season. Reuse ribbons & bows or place them in the trash.



Recycle Shipping and Gift Boxes

This holiday season, remember to empty, flatten, and recycle your shipping and gift boxes. When you flatten boxes in makes more room in your recycling bin.



Recycle While Cooking

Cooking this holiday season? Did you know items such as milk cartons, aluminum cans, and baking sheets can be recycled. Just make sure they are rinsed and dry before placing in the bin.
