




Change in OpenTable Reservations Daily Over-the-Year Percent Change






Change in Retail Sales, U.S. Monthly Over-the-Year Percent Change






U.S. Payroll Job Change by Sector Apr 2019 – Apr 2020

Total = -12.9% (19.4M)





Share of Rent Paid by the 13th, U.S.






Share of Rent In April, U.S.




Change in Housing Market Activity, Washington Region Monthly Over-the-Year Percent Change






Domestic Migration in the Washington Region 2000 to 2015






New Unemployment Insurance Claims (Excludes CARES Act)

■ D.C. ■ Maryland ■ Virginia






Unemployment Rate: Jobs Covered by Unemployment Insurance (Continued)






Continued Unemployment Insurance Claims State of Maryland






Change in Jobs By Select Area Monthly Over-the-Year Change








Business Applications Weekly Over-the-Year Change



Washington GRP 2007 – 2018 – 2024 (Annual % Change)






Downside Risk: Does Not Scale Proportionally
