Options for Virtual Participation

In addition to the provision that the TPB can schedule up to 3 100% virtual meetings:

- A. Bylaws remain as drafted
 Limits optional virtual participation in "in-person" meetings to 2 /year
 Potentially 5 of 11 meetings virtual participation
- B. Change the proposed limit from 2 to 4
 Limits optional virtual participation in "in-person" meetings to 4 /year
 Potentially 7 of 11 meetings virtual participation
- C. Replace limits on 2 optional virtual participations with requirement for 2 in-person participations
 Potentially 9 of 11 meetings virtual participation
- D. Maximum flexibility No limits on virtual participation OR requirements for in-person
- E. Other?

Section IV.2. Time & Place of Meeting

2. Virtual participation in an in-person meeting: When an in-person meeting is scheduled, a member may attend the meeting virtually (through electronic communication means) from a remote location, on no more than two (2) four (4) occasions in a year. The member wishing to participate virtually shall give at least three (3) days' notice to the Director or designated staff by either email or telephone. The Chair shall announce the names of the members participating virtually at the beginning of the meeting.



C. Replace limits on 2 virtual participations with requirement for 2 in-person participations.

Section IV.2. Time & Place of Meeting

2. Virtual In-person participation in an in-person meetings: While inperson participation of members in the meetings are preferred,
members are required to attend a minimum of two (2) meetings,
in-person, during a year. When an in-person meeting is
scheduled, a member may attend the meeting virtually (through
electronic communication means) from a remote location, on no
more than two (2) occasions in a year. The member wishing to
participate virtually, shall give at least three (3) days' notice to
the Director or designated staff by either email or telephone. The
Chair shall announce the names of the members participating
virtually at the beginning of the meeting.



D. No limits on virtual participation OR Requirements for inperson participation.

Section IV.2. Time & Place of Meeting

2. Virtual participation in an in-person meeting: When an in-person meeting is scheduled, a member may attend the meeting virtually (through electronic communication means) from a remote location, on no more than two (2) occasions in a year.
