Since the release of TravelMATE in 2014, The Arc of Northern Virginia has developed additional programs to assist people with cognitive challenges, including EmployMATE, which serves as a virtual "job coach in your pocket." The Arc of Northern Virginia's TRANSITION SUITE provides you with the tools you need to create personalized lessons and activities to support individuals with disabilities, as well as ONEder's capabilities for real-time data for tracking individual progress.

### The History – Grants

TravelMate is funded by USDOT – Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments.

**2013 – 2015 Grant –** The grant funded the training of forty travel trainers with TravelMATE, and represented 12 partner organizations, including four school districts.

**2017 – 2018 Grant –** The grant funds the training of the entire staff of TravelMATE partner organizations and provides access to the TravelMATE curriculum and ONEder's software.

#### The Stats - Travel Competence Achieved

Twenty-two of the Travel Trainers reported on the nature and level of the travel training competence achieved by 104 of their Travel Trainees, of whom:

96% of individuals decreased need of assistance in using public transportation and could travel more independently than before the training.

43% of individuals were able to travel completely independently using public transportation after the training.

56% of the trainers reported that TravelMATE was the most important and useful resource they received at the training.
