DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION

Detailed Capabilities Gap Assessment

- Focus on developing, conducting, and evaluating scenario driven workshops at the local level in order to identify POETE gaps as well as best practices.
- Focus will be on 8 priority core capabilities

Regional Exercise Series

- Will create a model for developing a repeatable regional exercise program that prepares the NCR to manage and coordinate the response to complex incidents
- Series will include:
 - Local jurisdictional tabletop exercises focused on:
 - Incident/Unified Command
 - Warm Zone Care
 - Mass Casualty and Mass Fatality Management
 - Public Information and Warning
 - Complex Incident Coordination
 - Subregional tabletop exercises
 - Regional tabletop exercise
 - Regional full scale exercise

Regional Approach

- All aspects of the project approach are regional in nature.

Project Management

- Financial Oversight and Program Management/Implementation will be managed by HSEMA

BACKGROUND

- Amount of competitive funding to be distributed is \$35,940,000
- Applications are due to DHS on February 10, 2017
- Projected period of performance start date is June 2017. The period of performance is 36 months.

IMPACT

- Region collaborates within the complex operating environment to function cohesively across jurisdictions
- Without CCTA grant funds, will still respond but will not be as coordinated

BUDGET

- Primary use of funds will be for combination of personnel, contractors, backfill/overtime
