Wendy Klancher, DTP The TPB is the designated recipient of the Federal Transit Administration's (FTA) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program funding for the Washington Urbanized Area. The Human Services Transportation Coordination Task Force is responsible for the development of the region's Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan and for overseeing the solicitation for the Section 5310 projects. The Technical Committee will be briefed on the CY 2014 solicitation which was conducted from August 28 to October 24, and on the status of the competitive selection process. At its January 21 meeting, the TPB will be asked to approve the selected projects for funding.
