CSX Freight Train Derails after Collision with Garbage Truck near Baltimore

Tuesday, May 28th, a CSX freight train crashed into a garbage-truck and derailed in Rosedale, east of Baltimore City. The derailment triggered a dramatic



explosion that caused damage to several structures near the crash site, including cracked foundations and blown windows. CSX and the National Transportation Safety Board are reviewing the crash scene and the heavily damaged areas. Fortunately no one was killed. The truck driver is recovering at the Maryland Shock Trauma Center. No other serious injuries have been reported.
