Why is Takoma Park doing an Energy Challenge?

Sustainable Energy Action Plan

- Finalized in 2014, identifies 17 key strategies for reducing greenhouse gas emissions in TKPK.
- Top recommendations include a tiered, voluntary residential program, direct installs and residential incentives, and leading by example.

• Semi-finalists in the Georgetown University Energy Prize

- 50 communities competing for 2 years to reduce municipal and residential energy use.
- \$5 Million Prize!

Neighborhood Energy Challenge

April 2015 – March 2016

- Year long competition
- 18 neighborhood teams
- \$2,000 Grand Prize
 - Awarded for most Green Home Certification Points
- Additional prizes and incentives available to participants
- Single family homes, apartments, and condos all can earn Green Home Certification points
- Multifamily buildings 12 units or more compete against each other for separate \$2,000 prize

Green Home Certification


- Mechanism for points in Neighborhood Energy Challenge
- Evergreen program, adaptable to future themes
- Tiered & flexible: budgets, barriers to entry, crazy housing stock
 - Light Green change lightbulbs, Free QHEC, thermostat settings, turn off unused items, clear area around vents, use shades/curtains. 10 pts
 - Medium Green energy audit, R49 & air leakage reduction, faucet aerators, filters, behaviors, fridge temps. 40 pts owner / 20 pts renter
 - Dark Green -all the above, plus renewable energy, ALL EnergyStar appliances, ceiling fans, motion detectors outdoors, programmable thermostat, etc. 100 pts owner / 40 pts renter
- City enhances EmPOWER MD rebates
 - \$100 audit rebate, 25% up to \$500 for improvements


