At the November 19 Board meeting, Vice Chairman Hanley announced the appointment of a Nominating Committee for year 2004 TPB officers. The committee included Mayor Porter, Senator Ticer, and Ms. Pourciau. The TPB Bylaws provide for TPB officers to serve for one calendar year, from January 1 through December 31. The Nominating Committee will present a slate of year 2004 officers for action by the Board.

Action: Approve the slate of TPB officers for the year 2004.

The TPB Public Involvement Process calls for the appointment of 15 members to the TPB CAC for each calendar year: six members designated by the current CAC, and nine members nominated by the TPB officers. The CAC for the year 2003 has designated six members for the year 2004. Chairman Shapiro will present the nine members (and alternates) nominated by the year 2004 TPB officers.

Action: Approve all of the recommended appointments to the CAC for the year 2004.

If the EPA approval of the new emissions budgets is received by December 17, the Board will be asked to approve the air quality conformity determination for the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP.

Action: Adopt Resolution R5-2004 finding that the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP conform with the requirements of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990.

If the air quality conformity determination under agenda item 8 is approved, the Board will be asked to approve the 2003 update to the CLRP.

Action: Adopt Resolution R6-2004 approving the 2003 update to the CLRP.
