
## Site of the New York Avenue Station

- √ \$103.7M Budget Funded by Federal Government, District of Columbia, and District Special Assessment.
- ✓ First in-fill station within the 103-Mile Metrorail System.
- ✓ Construction of a new Metrorail station along existing Red Line between Union Station and Rhode Island Avenue Stations.
- ✓ Major catalyst for the redevelopment of the New York Avenue gateway to the District of Columbia.




