#### Visualize 2045 Initiatives: Ped/Bike Station Access Update

The committee was briefed on a TPB project to identify a set of regionally prioritized high-capacity transit station areas with deficient pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure and where there is significant potential demand for more walking and biking. The development of this prioritized list will advance one of the seven aspirational initiatives of Visualize 2045 ("Improve Walk and Bike Access to Transit") and will fulfill the directive provided in TPB Resolution R10-2019, approved in December 2018. In recent months, staff has developed a preliminary list of priority station areas based on an analysis of regional data. The committee was informed that staff plans to meet with jurisdiction staff in the coming months to refine the list.
