Employer Outreach Ad Hoc Group Meeting Meeting Notes from July 20, 2004

Item #1 Introductions

Those attending introduced themselves (see attached list).

Item #2 Review of 5/18/04 Meeting Notes

The notes were approved as written.

Item #3 FY 2004 Commuter Survey Results

Staff presented and reviewed the final tabulation results with the group for the fiscal year 2004. Thirty-one employers were surveyed during the year and over 2,600 surveys were filled out and submitted by those companies. The overall response rate was 19% which was about the same for previous fiscal year (which was 20%).

Ms. Cynthia Capelli of Strategic Transportation Initiatives asked if the current fiscal year's budget was set to go. Mr. Nicholas Ramfos of COG replied that it was. Mr. Ramfos informed the group that the survey processing contract was renewed and that BMI won the bid and was retained as the survey processor. BMI will have new features such as direct access to reports online and the end user will be able to run cross tabs and comparisons. Some of the group asked if the survey could be changed and Mr. Ramfos responded that to ensure that the data collected from the surveys was reliable was that the questions were consistent for each survey.

Item #4 FY04 Draft Conformity Statement

Staff distributed and reviewed the draft conformity statement for FY04 with the group. As of the end of June, 2004 over 430 companies had either a Level 3 or Level 4 TDM program offered to their employees.

Item #5 FY04 Final Invoices and FY05 Scopes of Work

Staff informed the group that the final invoices for FY04 were due as the day of the meeting and if any had not yet billed COG that they do so as soon as they could so the books could be closed for FY04.

Item #6 Wilson Bridge Update

Ms. Michelle Holland of the Wilson Bridge Project updated the group on the progress of the Wilson Bridge construction and congestion assistance efforts for the affected commuting areas. The motto for congestion relief is "Mission Possible." After more than four years into construction, 30 of the 45 contracts have been completed. The Wilson

Bridge Project wants to get the word out to employers and working with the Commuter Connections Employer Outreach Group would be a beneficial partnership.

Item #7 NuRide Presentation

Mr. Rick Steele of NuRide presented the NuRide program to the group. The program is flexible and is a network of participants who enlist to share a ride and earn points towards store credits from vendors such as Home Depot and Starbucks Coffee. Currently the NuRide program is working with eleven large employers (AOL, Orbital Sciences, Shaw Pittman, and Oracle to name a few) in promoting the program at those employment sites. Mr. Steele demonstrated different aspects of the program such as miles saved, detailed analysis of commuters' trips, and networking with commuters.

Item #8 Employer Outreach Roundtable Discussion

Mr. Ramfos informed the group of the new Park and Ride map that Commuter Connections produced and distributed samples for the group.

Item #9 Other Business

The meeting adjourned at its designated time. The next meeting date is October 19th, 2004.
