# CAC Mission

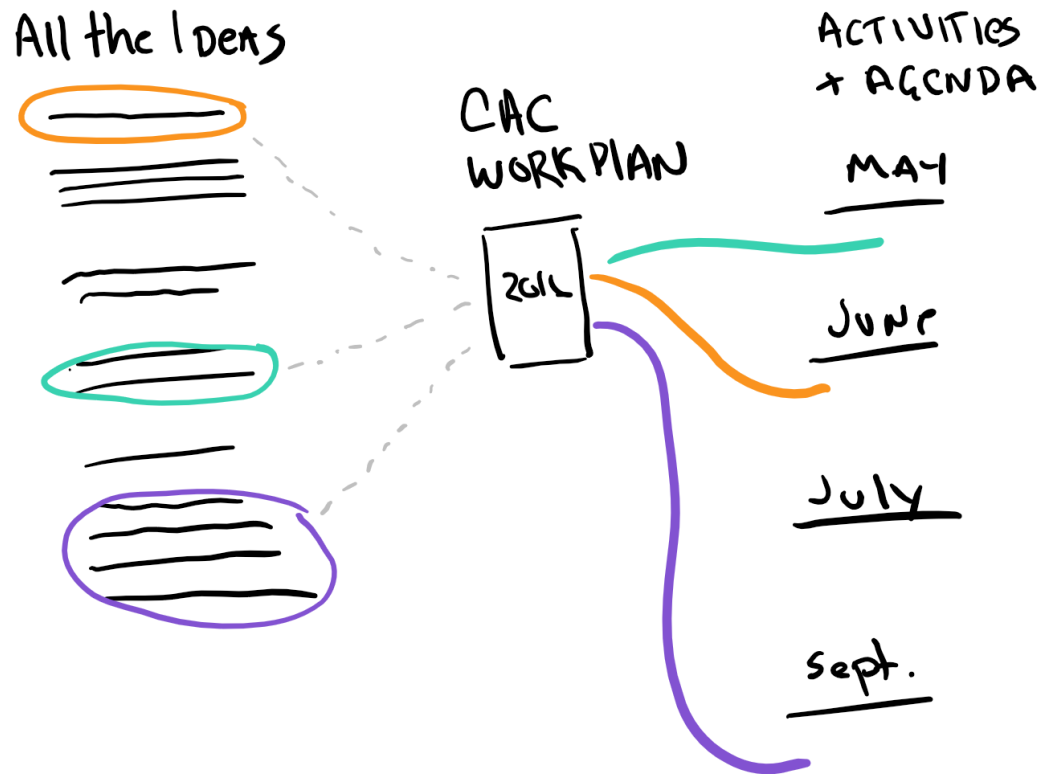
---

- Other CAC Priorities?



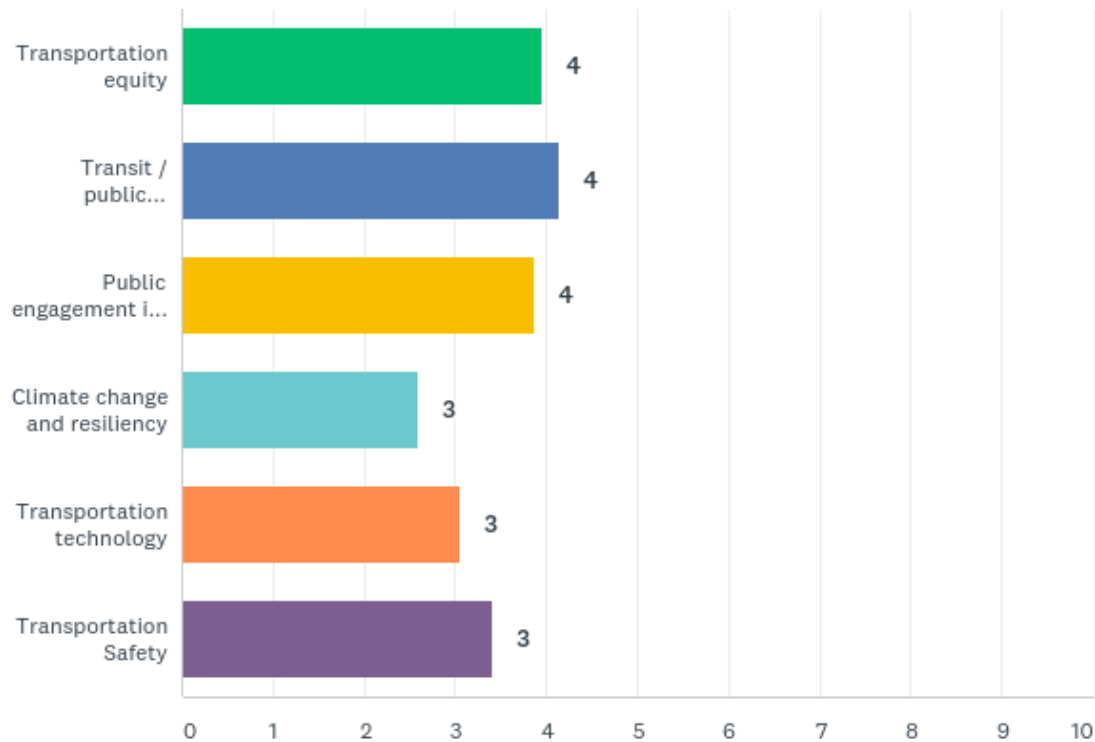
