

Traditional Project Timelines

Overall timeline: 5-10 years minimum, multiple decades in some cases of major projects from planning to construction is completed

Crashes, injuries, and deaths may continue happening while project develops




By the time they are constructed they are often out of date with current practice or may not meet goals, policies, and agency direction any longer



If designs change, money spent may need to be returned (especially if grant funded), or may need more funding with cost increases



Florida Ave NE – Final Design and Construction




- Interim was in place since summer of 2019

DC Kipp Somerset – After Safety Improvements


- High visibility crosswalk Improves pedestrian safety by alerting drivers
- Concrete pedestrian island Provides safe place for pedestrians to stop if they cannot cross both lanes
- Rectangular rapid flashing beacon

 Alerts drivers to pedestrians
 crossing
- 4. Flex post and painted curb extensions Improves visibility, shortens pedestrian crossing distances
- Art in the Right of Way (AROW) -Defines pedestrian-only areas
- 6. Flex post and yellow painted median Narrows road and slows vehicles
- 7. Painted parking box Prevents parking too close to crosswalks and obstructing visibility. Narrows road and slows vehicles




Wheeler Road and Mississippi Avenue – After Safety Improvements

- Left turn pocket lane Reduces rearend and left-turn crashes
- 2. Flex post and painted curb extensions Slows right turning vehicles, improves visibility, shortens pedestrian crossing distances
- Art in the Right of Way (AROW) Defines pedestrian-only areas
- Left turn calming Slows left turning vehicles and prevents crossing double line
- Flex post and yellow painted median – Narrows road and slows vehicles
- Updated signs (not shown) –
 Communicates clear traffic laws to drivers






Notice of Infraction (Speeding Tickets)




Wheeler Road Travel Time Southern Avenue to Alabama Avenue




Wheeler Road – Long term streetscape
