

Ozone Standards & SIPs

Current Ozone Standard: 75 ppb




EPA Approvals & Proposals 1997 Ozone SIP (84 ppb)

- EPA approved components of ozone SIP:
 - ✓ Base year 2002 emissions inventory
 - ✓ Reasonably available control measures/technology (RACM/RACT)
 - ✓ 2008 Reasonable Further Progress (RFP) plan & 2008 mobile budgets*
 - ✓ RFP Contingency measures (in case RFP requirements not met)
- EPA proposing to approve remaining components:
 - Attainment demonstration & 2009 mobile budgets
 - Attainment Contingency measures & 2010 mobile budgets (in case of non-attainment by required date)
 - * Mobile budget Limit on motor vehicle emissions set in SIP

 TPB Annual transportation conformity analysis to ensure Washington region's motor vehicle emissions remain below mobile budgets

EPA Approvals & Proposals 1997 Ozone SIP (84 ppb)

- Why EPA is proposing to approve these?
 - Washington region demonstrated attainment by the applicable attainment date of June 15, 2010



- Approval strengthens the ozone SIP by
 - Reserving reductions from various measures for air quality purposes
 - Approving stricter 2009 attainment & 2010 contingency mobile budgets than previously approved 2008 RFP mobile budgets




EPA Adequacy Finding Mobile Budgets (1997 Ozone Standard, 84 ppb)

- Washington region Ozone SIP
 - Mobile Budgets for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) & Nitrogen Oxides (NOx) - Ozone precursors
 - √ 2008 Reasonable Further Progress budget
 - 2009 Attainment budget
 - 2010 Attainment Contingency budget
- EPA 2009/10 Mobile budgets in ozone SIP "adequate" for conformity (Effective February 22, 2013)
- EPA proposing to "approve" the above "adequate" budgets
- Conformity analysis Test future motor vehicle emissions against
 "adequate" mobile budgets starting 2012 CLRP analysis

Ozone Mobile Budgets & Conformity




Ozone Mobile Budgets & Conformity



Conformity Tests & Ozone Standards

- Current conformity test 1997 Ozone Standard (84 ppb) SIP budget
- Stricter conformity test 2008 Ozone Standard (75 ppb) SIP budget (if required to develop a SIP with mobile budget)



MWAQC Comment Letter

Amendment to updated 2012 CLRP Analysis

- Transportation Planning Board (TPB)
 - Amended the updated 2012 CLRP & FY2013-18 TIP
 - Included ozone mobile budgets found "adequate" by EPA on February 7, 2013 (Budgets effective Feb 22, 2013)
- MWAQC Comment Letter
 - Concurs mobile emissions are below
 - "Adequate" mobile budgets for 1997 ozone standard (84 ppb)
 - Approved mobile budgets for 1971 Carbon Monoxide standard
 - Meets base year 2002 emissions tests for the annual fine particulate matter (PM2.5) standard

MWAQC Comment Letter Amendment to updated 2012 CLRP Analysis

- MWAQC Comment Letter
 - Cautions "adequate" mobile budgets are
 - Several years old
 - Apply to old 1997 ozone standard (84 ppb)
 - Do not reflect levels of mobile emissions required to achieve the new stricter
 2008 ozone standard (75 ppb)
 - Washington region Marginal nonattainment for 2008 ozone standard
 - Attainment deadline December 31, 2015
 - Emissions reduction needed across all sectors to attain 2008 ozone standard

Urges TPB

- To continue investment in public transit, ride-sharing, and transit-oriented development to mitigate future growth in vehicle emissions
- Maintain commitments to Transportation Emission Reduction Measures and other emission reduction measures.
