Compost Crew is a Rockville-based business that diverts tens of thousands of tons of organic waste from landfills, each year.

We haul organic waste from nearly 20,000 residents and businesses across the DMV.

We offer a variety of services including weekly curbside pick-up, community programs, drop-off locations, roll-off and operating local composting sites.

DISTRIBUTED COMPOSTING



Compost Crew establishes food scrap recycling programs for communities, municipalities and businesses, with a focus on decentralized composting to support local food production and soil health.



COLLECTIONS: COLLEGE PARK



- Built on an existing drop off program by rolling out curbside collection in November 2022
- Started with ~190 homes; has grown to nearly 400
- Diverted 60K pounds of food scraps in the first 9 months

COLLECTIONS: ALEXANDRIA

- After an earlier test run, Alexandria began its curbside collection program in April 2023
- Launched with 364 homes & has grown to 900+ today
- First six months is fully-subsidized, then resident assumes responsibility for monthly fees

PROCESSING: FAIRFAX COUNTY



- Our first Compost Outpost (processing site) in partnership with local government
- Built at the County transfer station, taking advantage of space & existing food scrap drop-off location
- Processing 1 ton a week in this small-scale pilot project










CAPACITY VS COLLECTIONS
