The LEED Rating System

LEED stands for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design and is used in rating a worksite for certification levels.

The US Green Building Council evaluates how the building or worksite achieves its Green Building level of LEED certification. There are six key areas of performance that are used to determine that certification.

They are:

- Sustainable Sites
- Water Efficiency
- Energy & Atmosphere
- Materials & Resources
- Indoor Environmental Quality
- Innovation in Operations

There are **two** types of categories of worksites where offering commuting options can be submitted for LEED certification:

- Existing Building - LEED EB
- New Construction - LEED NC
